Las bodas se programan con cita previa, con seis meses de antelación. Por favor, póngase en contacto con Mayra.

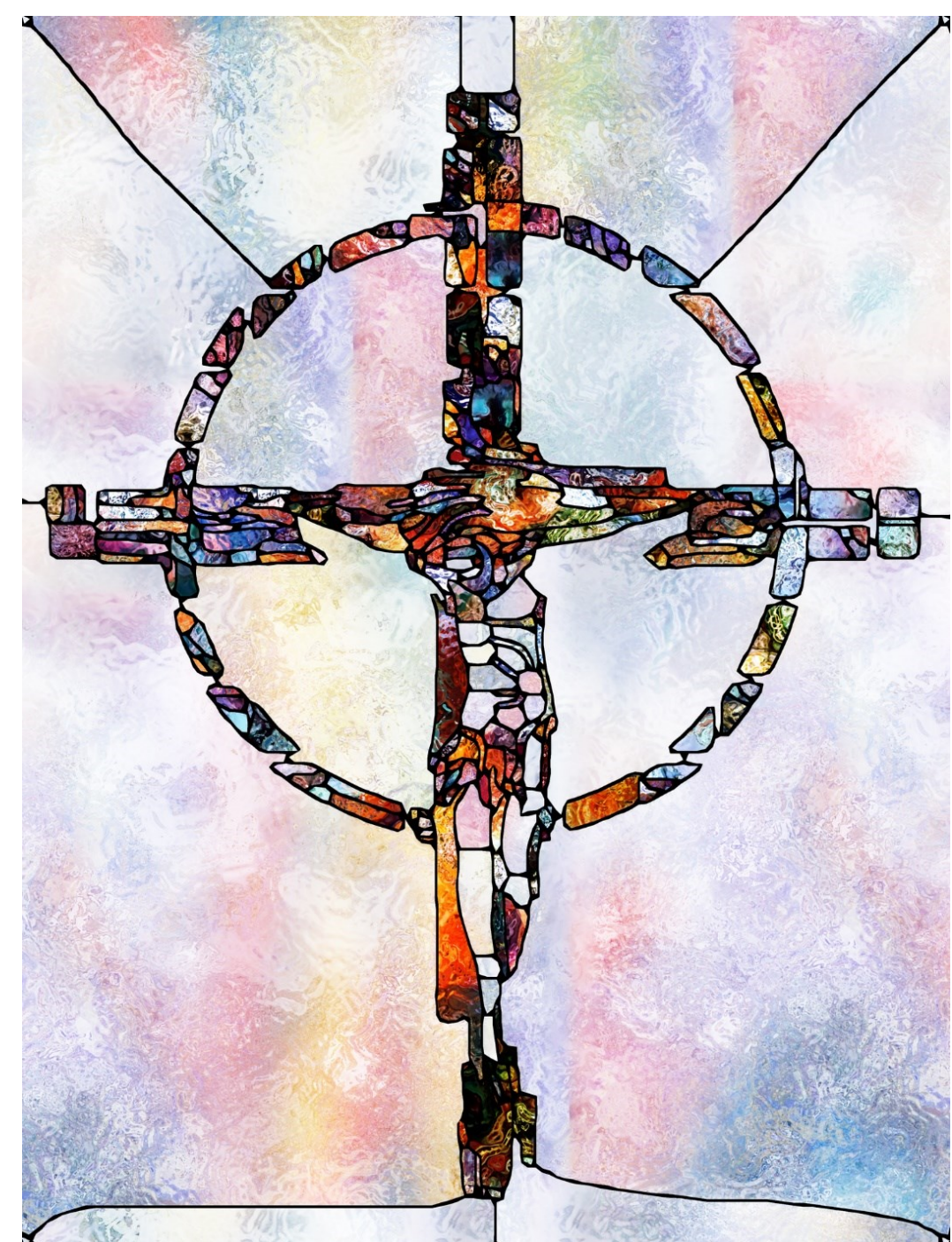
